Health & Safety Policy

Statement of Intent

Mr Bouncy Castle Ltd is fully committed to ensuring the **health, safety, and welfare** of our customers, employees, and members of the public who may be affected by our activities.

Safety is our **highest priority** and is central to every aspect of our business, from equipment selection and maintenance to delivery, setup, supervision, and collection. We aim to meet and, where possible, exceed all relevant health and safety legislation, industry guidance, and best practice within the inflatable hire industry.

This policy supports our detailed **Method Statement**, which outlines our operational procedures and control measures in full.

Our Responsibilities

Mr Bouncy Castle Ltd will:

- Provide and maintain equipment that is **safe, suitable, and properly maintained**
 - Ensure all inflatables comply with **BS EN 14960** standards
 - Carry out **PIPA testing annually** and display valid PIPA tags on all inflatables
 - Ensure all electrical equipment is **PAT tested annually**
 - Maintain appropriate **Public Liability Insurance**
 - Provide clear safety information to customers
 - Ensure all staff are properly trained and competent
 - Regularly review and improve our safety procedures
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Equipment Safety

All inflatables and ancillary equipment supplied by Mr Bouncy Castle Ltd are:

- Tested annually in accordance with **BS EN 14960**
- Clearly labelled with a **valid PIPA test tag**
- Visually inspected before and after every hire
- Cleaned, maintained, and stored to a high standard

All electrical equipment, including blowers and extension leads, is **PAT tested by an independent contractor every 12 months**.

Training & Staff Competence

All employees undergo **comprehensive on-the-job training**, including:

- Safe delivery and manual handling
- Correct setup, anchoring, and dismantling of inflatables
- Equipment inspection procedures
- Weather monitoring and response
- Customer safety briefings
- Emergency procedures

Staff must demonstrate a clear understanding of our **Method Statement** and are required to sign an agreement confirming their **duty of care** to customers, the public, and fellow employees.

Periodic **spot checks and supervision** are carried out to ensure procedures are followed consistently.

Method Statement & Risk Assessments

Mr Bouncy Castle Ltd maintains a detailed **Method Statement**, which includes procedures covering:

- Equipment care and inspection
- Vehicle and unit safety
- Delivery, setup, and collection
- Safe anchoring methods
- Weather monitoring and wind limits
- Generator use
- Supervision requirements
- Event and public hire setups

Supporting **risk assessments and test certificates** are available on our website and can be provided upon request.

Customer Responsibilities

While Mr Bouncy Castle Ltd takes all reasonable steps to ensure safety, customers also have a responsibility to:

- Provide a suitable, clear, and safe setup area
- Ensure inflatables are **supervised by a responsible adult at all times**
- Follow all safety instructions provided on delivery
- Monitor weather conditions during the hire period
- Prevent misuse of the equipment

Customers are encouraged to review the **risk assessments, method statement, and safety guidance** provided prior to their event.

Each booking includes a **Health & Safety information guide** highlighting the most important safety points, including supervision, weather awareness, and correct use.

Monitoring & Review

This Health & Safety Policy is reviewed **regularly** and updated as required to reflect changes in legislation, industry guidance, or company operations.
